

Teacher Check List:

- Reserve a school bus at least 3 weeks in advance.
- Do the pre-site activities prior to your program.
- Enlist adult field trip assistants (one for every six students).
- Copy and give each student a checklist of what to wear, bring, etc.
- If you have a substitute, please be sure he/she has all this information.
- Bring the map for the bus driver.
- Supply nametags for each student and adult.
- Plan to arrive on time at the correct location.
- Do you have any students with special needs? Please notify Red Rock Canyon staff in advance.

Other Important Things to Remember:

- No drinking water is available on the scenic drive.
- Groups should carry out all their own trash.
- Please stay as close to your itinerary as possible.
- Teachers and chaperons are responsible for the conduct of their group.
- All natural and cultural items must be left at the Conservation Area, including: rocks and plants.

Dear Parent/Student:

We are going on a field trip to Red Rock Canyon!! We will be hiking and/or doing hands-on activities with the Park Rangers. Here is a checklist of what you need for the field trip:

What to wear:

- Wear long pants and short sleeve shirt. If it's cold or rainy, bring a jacket or raincoat. It is usually about 10 degrees cooler at Red Rock Canyon than it is in town.
- Very heavy boots or shoes suitable for hiking. No open toe shoes!! The plants will poke you. Ouch!!
- Wear a hat with a brim to protect you from the sun's rays.

What to bring:

- Lunch and a filled water bottle.
- Sunscreen for you face and arms.
- Pencil and notepaper.
